## July Hijiori Hot Spring Opening Festival



This is a Shinto ritual held on July 14, which is considered to be the opening day of Hijiori Hot Spring. The Jizo Mikoshi (portable shrine) features various activities, including one in which hot water is poured on the portable shrine, during which time the hot spring town is filled with a great bustle. We thank the god of hot springs and praise the great deeds of our ancestors who conserved the hot springs through the ages.

## July to October HIJIORI NO HI



On summer nights, lanterns are lit up in the hot spring town. The lantern paintings for "HIJIORI NO HI" are done by artists who stay in the area and research the goings-on. Please enjoy "Hijiori Story," which depicts various aspects of Hijiori Hot Spring's natural surroundings, landscape, lifestyle, and hot spring cure culture.

## August Shikamura Rice Terrace HOTARUBI Concert



This is an event that features one of Japan's top 100 rice terraces, "The Rice Terraces of Shikamura." The sounds of the concert echo through the terraced rice fields, lit by approximately 1,200 "HOTARUBI" Enjoy this fantastic world that lasts one night only.

## August Hijiori Onsen Yuza Shrine Festival



This is a festival at Yuza Shrine (Yakushi Shrine), the god of hot springs. On the 16th, there will be a "Costume Play Bon Dance" and on the 20th, a "sumo tournament" will be held during the main festival.

## January "Hijiori Sange Sange"



This is a New Year's Eve event held by mountain priests that has been passed down in Dewa Sanzan since ancient times. January 7th, dressed in white robes, they pray for a bountiful harvest and good health, and parade through the hot spring town to the sound of the conch shell. Freshly made mochi (rice cake) is served to the visitors.

## January to February Hijiori Fantasy Snow Corridor



This is an event unique to Hijiori, one of the heaviest snowfall areas in Japan. Dim lights gently illuminate a snow wall that is more than three meters high. Enjoy a winter walk amid the light reflected off the snow.

## February JIMENDASHI World Cup in Hijiori



Teams compete to see how quickly they can dig through the snow and reveal the ground. It may seem simple, but it's a profound sport that requires both power and technique.

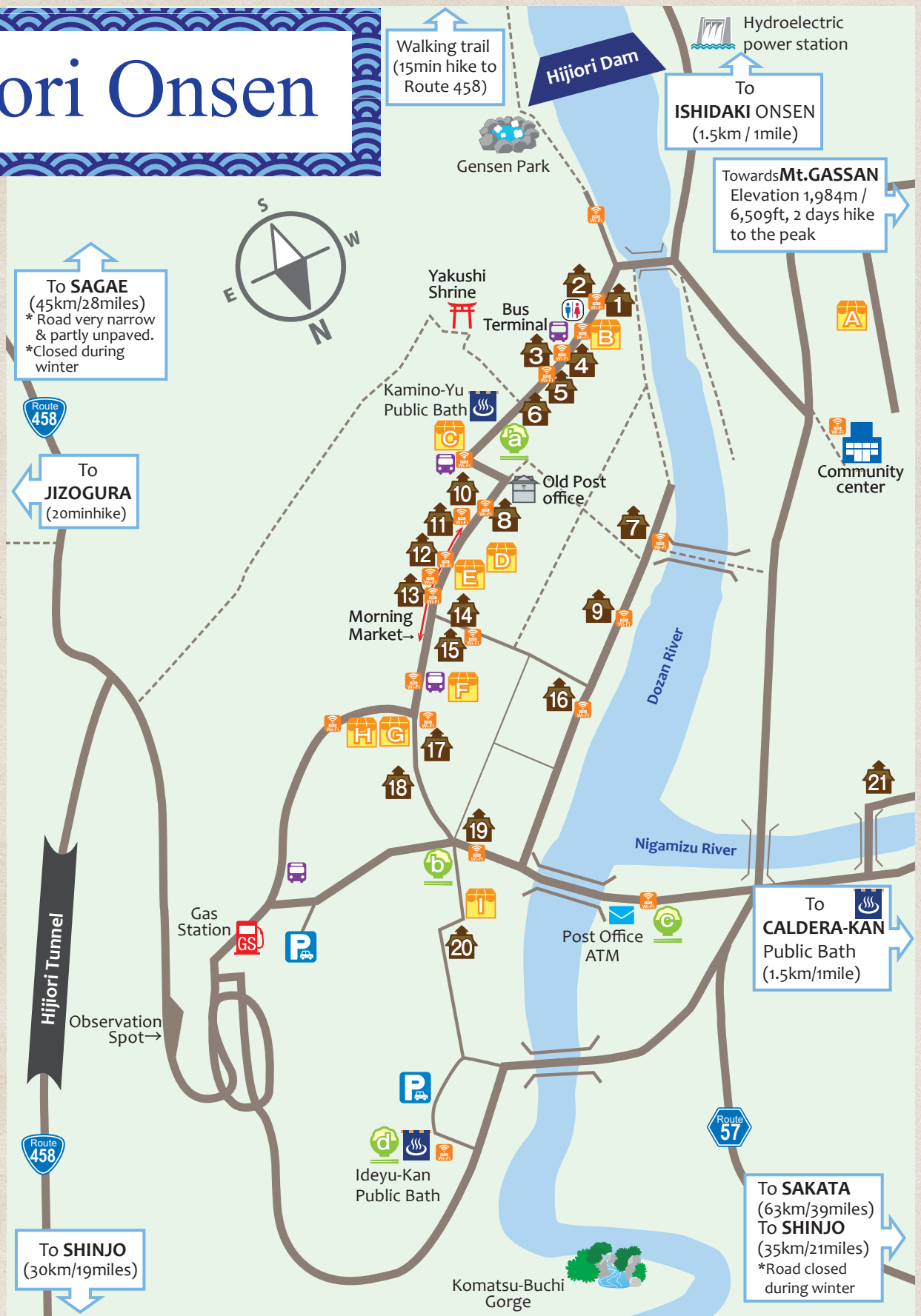
